# Yoshinao Mishima is new President of Tokyo Tech



On 1 October 2012, Dr Yoshinao Mishima, who served as President of IFHTSE for the two years 2006-07 was appointed President of the Tokyo Institute of Technology, where he graduated in 1969. After six years in the USA, including receiving his PhD from the University of California, he returned to work at the Institute as an assistant professor. Most recently, until his appointment as President, he was Executive Vice President for Education and International Affairs.

Established in 1881, Tokyo Institute of Technology is one of Japan's leading educational institutions in the field of science and technology. With the aim of providing an all-round education, the institute emphasizes both technical and cultural skills to prepare students to become educators, researchers, engineers and managers. Tokyo Tech comprises three schools, six graduate schools, four affiliated research centres and a number of other educational facilities, and receives applications from qualified applicants around the world.

Tokyo Tech's International Graduate Program aims to offer qualified students from outside Japan an opportunity to enrol directly in the Master's or Doctoral programs at Tokyo Tech, with little or no knowledge of Japanese, to pursue a full-degree program of advanced studies in Japan. As lectures and seminars are conducted in English, it is no longer essential to master the Japanese language. Faculties in charge of each International Graduate Program are those of the relevant Tokyo Tech Graduate School departments; (though not all Tokyo Tech faculty teach in the International Graduate Program; interested applicants should refer to the Tokyo Tech website to confirm which faculties are actually involved in the International Graduate Program).

This is particularly welcome because the Swiss leaders did so much in the earlier years of IFHTSE. Dr H U Meyer, Climax Molybdenum Zurich was our first President, in office from 1971 to 1974. Urs Wyss, MAAG Gear, was the first Secretary, a post he held from foundation until 1988 (and he was Treasurer for several years after that). Urs was also a recipient of the IFHTSE Medal, which he was awarded at the 15th Congress in Vienna in 2005.
