


AWARD FOR EVA TROELL

This event was attended by about 100 people from 8 countries; it had the support of several Chinese authorities and included a range of invited papers. A selection of the papers is being reviewed for publication by IFHTSE.

Discussions on the already wide range of topics covered by this series yielded the suggestion that future conferences should also cover environmental issues of heat treatment and surface engineering. Proposals for no. 3 in the series will be welcome from IFHTSE member bodies – as will suggestions for a comprehensive but comprehensible re-titling!

IFHTSE Executive Committee meeting 10 October 2014: The meeting of the IFHTSE Executive Committee held the day before the Conference handled a very full agenda including the matter of replacing the Secretary and Treasurer (see page 1). The Committee had been tasked with

finding replacements for the current holders of the posts by the 43rd Assembly of the Governing Council held in Munich Germany last May. Assuming the formal approval by members of the Committee's successful efforts, Dr Hock will become Secretary on 1 January 2015 and Dr Felde will take over the Treasury with effect from the completion of the financial report and audit for the 2014 operating year at the 44th Assembly of the Governing Council scheduled for Venice/Mestre Italy in May 2015 at the time of the 21st IFHTSE Congress.

Before the meeting of the Committee, its members held a detailed discussion with representatives of Chinese Heat Treatment Society and Shanghai Jiao Tong University on the immediate and longer-term future of the Journal *International Heat Treatment and Surface Engineering*, now in its 8th volume. 
