Obituary

IFHTSE mourns the death of our friend and colleague Kiyoshi Funatani.



Dr Kiyoshi Funatani served our organization, the IFHTSE, as a member of the Executive Committee (EC) over the 15 years from 2000, initially co-opted then latterly as a full member. He ended his involvement in the IFHTSE EC only last December (2015) when he retired from full time activity.

He was universally recognised for his enthusiastic approach to heat treatment technology over his entire working life. He was a constant observer and evaluator of existing and emerging heat treatment technologies, and never afraid to put forward his

strong but well-informed personal views and judgments in his excellent presentations. His long-term interactions with experts in the West enabled him to become a valued and enlightening interpreter of the differences in Western and Japanese approaches.

In addition to his numerous contributions to the literature through conference presentations and journals, he was co-editor of the 'Handbook of Metallurgical Process Design' and 'Handbook of Mechanical Alloy Design' and a contributing author to the 'Handbook of Residual Stress and Deformation of Steel'.

Not surprisingly, Funatani was among the first to be awarded IFHTSE Fellowship (2002) "In recognition of the industrialisation of diverse surface engineering technologies in the automotive sector".

Even after retirement from formal association with the IFHTSE EC, he remained an invaluable contact for all of us, and the news of this passing leaves us with a deep sadness.
