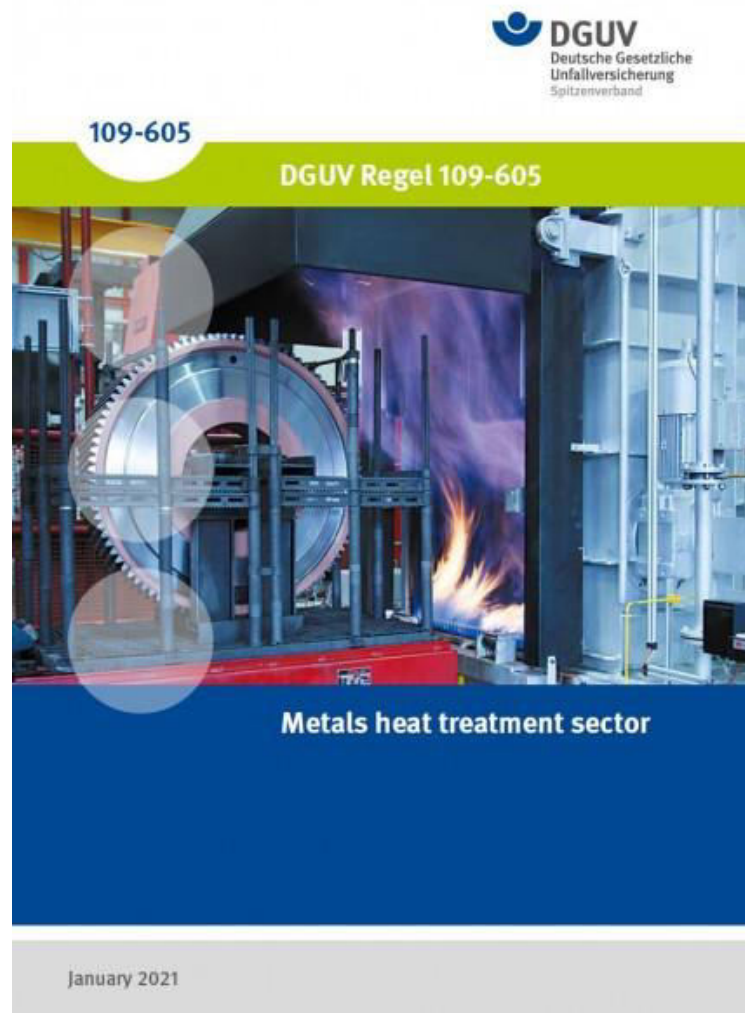


New Guide to Safety in Heat Treatment Operations

The Expert Committee #8 “Safety regulations in heat treatment companies” of our German member association AWT has compiled a comprehensive manual of hazards to be aware of and rules to follow in Heat Treatment shops. The 96-page document, full of instructive illustrations, refers to German statutory regulations and standards which in turn are based on underlying European legislation. It also contains a wealth of practical tips and information on implementing occupational safety and health effectively in the company and thus supports the employer in the assessment of hazards and the development of measures for the minimization of these hazards. Last but not least, it contains three pages with a bulk of references to standards, government and association acts and ordinances, and technical rules. The booklet was published by the German Statutory Accident Insurance DGUV originally in German. But because of the general applicability of the guide, compiled with the common year-long experience of leading experts, DGUV was wise enough to publish also an English version.
