Munich, Germany 12-15 May 2014

The 2014 European conference on heat treatment and surface engineering is merged with the 21st Congress of the International Federation for Heat Treatment and Surface Engineering. This joint event, organised by AWT Bremen, Germany, in close cooperation with IFHTSE and other European associations for heat treatment, takes place in May 2014 in Munich, Germany, at the Haus der Bayerischen Wirtschaft.

World Tribology Congress update

The World Tribology Congress yields some impressive statistics. The now very well established series started in London England in 1997. (IFHTSE people Tom Bell and Bob Wood were members of the Organising Committee for that first event, which an attendance of 1100). Numbers 2, 3 and 4 in the series were held in Vienna Austria 2001, Washington DC USA 2005, and Kyoto japan 2009 and continued the high performance.

The Fifth in the series took place in September in Torino/Turin Italy under the 'High Patronage' of the President of Italy. The attendance of about 1400 came from 74 countries. The event presented 825 papers covering all modern aspects of tribology, also including:

- Biotribology
- Ecotribology
- Nanotribology
- Environmental Tribology

The 6th World Tribology Congress is scheduled for Beijing China in 2017.

Southampton England 27 November 2013

The UK National Centre for Advanced Tribology at Southampton England (nCATS) in collaboration with Rolls-Royce plc is organising a free half day workshop to address key issues around Robust Tribological Testing.

This workshop, on 27 November 2013 at the Hilton Southampton will discuss current efforts to address the reliability of tribological test data. This will be informed by the results of a UK national tribological survey; discussion will include sharing test data between academia and industry; intellectual property issues; future directions in testing and knowledge capture; overcoming challenges on a short to medium term basis.


